Family member and survivor input on the future of the Pulse building

Significant majority* of family members and survivors who responded believe **Pulse building should be demolished**, provided that:

- some features are retained (original sign, chandelier, water feature, pieces of bathroom all mentioned)
- Families/survivors can see interior of building before demolition

*A few who were contacted want the entire building preserved

Opinión de los familiares y sobrevivientes sobre el futuro del edificio Pulse

Una gran mayoría* de los familiares y sobrevivientes que respondieron creen que el **edificio Pulse debería demolerse**, siempre que:

- se conserven algunos elementos (cartel original, candelabro de techo, fuente de agua, partes del baño).
- Los familiares / sobrevivientes puedan ver el interior del edificio antes de la demolición.

*Algunas de las personas contactadas quieren que se conserve todo el edificio.

Summary of other input from families and survivors (obtained via email and phone calls, in English and Spanish)

Calls placed in English (on top of emails): 164
Calls placed in Spanish (on top of emails): 36

Conversations/responses in English: 17 (about half email, half calls)
Conversations/responses in Spanish: 10 (one email, nine calls)

Memorial Elements: There's general agreement on including the names and images of victims, parking, restrooms, trees, and landscaping.

- some support for:
 - water features (some yes, some no)
 - text about victims and survivors (split)
 - historical info about Pulse

Other Concerns: Some people want to ensure the memorial is respectful to all victims and survivors, while others want to avoid it becoming a flashpoint for anti-LGBTQ+ sentiment. Historic site designation was encouraged along with multilingual access.

Otras sugerencias de familias y sobrevivientes (recibidas por correo electrónico y llamadas telefónicas, en inglés y español)

Llamadas en inglés (además de correos electrónicos): 164
Llamadas en español (además de correos electrónicos): 36

Respuestas/conversaciones en inglés: 17 (la mitad correos electrónicos, la mitad llamadas)
Respuestas/conversaciones en español: 10 (1 correo electrónico, 9 llamadas)

Elementos del monumento: Hay un acuerdo general de incluir los nombres e imágenes de las víctimas, estacionamiento, baños, árboles y paisajismo.

- cierto apoyo para:
 - detalles con agua (algunos sí, otros no)
 - texto sobre víctimas y sobrevivientes (dividido)
 - información histórica de Pulse

Inquietudes: algunos desean asegurar de que el monumento guarde respeto a todas las víctimas y sobrevivientes, mientras que otros desean evitar que sea blanco de sentimientos anti-LGBTQ+. Promover su designación como lugar histórico con acceso multilingüe
